Sets ups and operates radio, audio, or video equipment. Maintains equipment inventory records.

A high school diploma and two years of appropriate experience. Appropriate college course work or vocational or technical training may substitute at an equivalent rate for the required experience.

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# Job Title: Broadcast Production Program Assistant

Primary Responsibility

Positions television cameras, lighting and sound equipment, and visual materials for video or audio productions.
