Prepares and maintains laboratory budget.

Researches and evaluates new products and compare and negotiates best prices.

Prepares justification for new laboratory equipment purchases.

Oversees the maintenance and repair of laboratory equipment.

Categorizes and stores sensitive scientific materials and instruments.

Insures compliance with all regulations for hazardous waste disposal.

Insures laboratory users comply with laboratory procedures and adhere to safety procedures.

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Job Title: Laboratory Technician

Primary Responsibility

This is work providing basic laboratory assistance.

Typical Tasks

Sets up and operates laboratory equipment.

Assists students in the laboratory.

Prepares specimens and samples for laboratory study.

Minimum Qualifications

A high school diploma and two years of appropriate experience. Appropriate college coursework or vocational or technical training may substitute at an equivalent rate for the required experience.

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Job Title: Laboratory Animal Technician

Job Code: 275

Overtime Pay: Eligible

Primary Responsibility

This is work providing care for animals.

Typical Tasks

Observes and detects changes in animals change in behavior, appetite, and signs of illness or pain.

Monitors environmental conditions and report changes.

Performs husbandry procedures daily.

Performs routine treatments as prescribed.

Maintains cleanliness of work area and quality and safety standards.

Operates specialized equipment including cage washer and autoclaves.

Alerts supervisor and Principal Investigator of problems.

Adheres to laboratory animal care procedures.

Maintains records and files.

Maintains inventory and inform manager to order supplies and equipment.

Performs some clerical duties.

Minimum Qualifications

High school diploma and two years of appropriate experience; or certification as Assistant Laboratory Animal Technician or above by the Animal Association for Laboratory Animal Science. Appropriate college coursework or vocational/technical training may substitute at an equivalent rate for required experience.

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
