Admission to UCF





Admission to UCF

- Apply Early
- Dates to Remember:
 - Summer Term: March 1
 - Fall Term: July 1 (Transfer) May 1 (FTIC)
 - Spring Term: November 1





Components of a Completed FTIC Application

- Completed application form (online only) https://apply.ucf.edu/application
- \$30 application fee
- Official high school transcript (GPA is re-calculated on Academic Core)
- SAT / ACT Scores
- Essay (strongly recommended)

Components of a Completed Transfer Application

Admission requirements depend upon the number of credit hours completed:

- Lower division transfer: < 60 college credit hrs.
 - Competitive freshman credentials
 - Competitive college GPA
- Application, official SAT/ACT scores, official high school transcript and official transcripts from all previously attended institutions required for review.





Components of a Completed Transfer Application

Admission requirements depend upon the number of credit hours completed:

- Upper division transfer: ≥ 60 college credit hrs.
 - Competitive college GPA
 - English, Math and World Language requirements satisfied
- Application and official transcripts from all previously attended institutions required for review.
- AA degree recipients from Florida Public Community and State Colleges will receive admission preference.

- Guarantees admission to UCF with an AA or State Articulated AS degree from partner colleges.

Helpful Hints





- Pay attention to deadlines
- Choose a major before you enroll
 - Do your research
 - Indicate it on the application
 - Take appropriate prerequisites
- Register for an early Orientation


