Cyber security was in the spotlight at recent Luncheon

Technology – it's an almost magical tool that has revolutionized many aspects of our everyday lives, both large and small. From the manner in which we communicate, share photos, and conduct business to the method that data about us is created and managed, technology is the driving mechanism, most generally via the Internet.

Kittie Johnson, guest speaker at the Association's Spring Luncheon, shared advice on how to keep your information secure. As the founder of Winter Park Tech Tutors, Kittie advised audience members to make "cyber vigilance" an ongoing habit. Among the key points she suggested were these:

- Back up data regularly
- Install security software
- Don't email personal or financial information
- Don't open email attachments unless you know and trust the sender
- Be "unpredictable" when creating passwords — and mix in numbers, symbols, and capital letters
- Don't use the same password for many accounts
- If you spot a scam, report it to the Federal Trade Commission at 1-877-382-4357.







the UCF Bookstore) along with your application.

For those selecting the mail-in option, Parking Services will begin mailing out new permits for the 2018-19 academic year after August 6th.
