- Works closely with executive sponsors to implement a structure that creates close sponsor and stakeholder collaboration with frequent informal and formal communication
- Engages in the creation and implementation of recommendations that strengthen the operations of the university and drive a culture of efficiency and effectiveness
- Works closely with the Chief Operating Officer and the Chief Financial Officer to capture efficiencies so they can be re-invested in university wide priorities
- Convenes stakeholders from across the university and community to drive decisions, build support, and create momentum for strategic initiatives outlined by the President
- Works to remove barriers for cross-function teams so they can best accomplish their goals
- Serves as a member of the President's Operations Team to support the operations of the Office of the President
- Provides transitional leadership to offices in the Division of Partnership and Innovation, including UCF Downtown as long term organizational structures are developed
