**Job Summary**

Responsible for working directly with children and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD), their families/caregivers, and the educational and local agencies serving children and adults with autism related disabilities. Supports or delivers, consultation, training content and programs for professional development reflecting understanding of Autism Spectrum Disorders and related disabilities, and direct consultative services to children and adults with ASD and their families.

**Representative Duties**

- Maintains active caseload and delivers in-home and community-based consultations with families and adults with ASD, and provides regional support for other stakeholders
- Develops and models intervention programs, communication and behavior supports with families and educators
- Provides professional and parent education programs and content as requested by supervisor
- Conducts school and community consultations and in-home visits
- Participates in case conferences, staff meetings, and regularly scheduled meetings at UCF as requested by supervisor
- Develops and maintains a resource network of appropriate refererals related to client needs
- Assists in implementing center goals and strategies
- Collaborates effectively with other Autism Disorders Specialists to support ongoing programs and initiatives
- Writes and maintains case reports, electronic client records, reports and other professional correspondence
