What to do if your condition changes while at work or at home:

If you develop the above symptoms, feel feverish, develop a cough, or have difficulty breathing while you are self-observing on campus or at home, you should:

- Maintain 6-foot distance between yourself and others.
- Contact your healthcare provider or call UCF Health at 407-266-3627 for a telehealth visit.
- Notify your supervisor.
- Report if you have tested positive for COVID-19 by calling the UCF COVID Line: 407-823-2509.
- Provide your supervisor with medical clearance from your healthcare provider, once applicable, so you can return to work.
