Job Summary

Supports health profession educators in the development and implementation of simulated patient encounters, by directly overseeing and training the work of standardized patients (SPs) at the UCF College of Medicine SP Program. Primary responsibilities of Standardized Patient Educators include recruiting, training, casting, assessment and quality improvement of the standardized program.

Representative Duties

1. Education and Training

- Recruits, trains, and mentors standardized patients for healthcare simulations supported by the UCF COM SP Program
- Ensures that standardized patients have materials necessary and full understanding of simulation goals
- Directly trains and provides feedback to SPs on case portrayal, completion of assessment tools, and student feedback skills
- Facilitates communication to standardized patients for simulations
- Ensures that schedules, materials, and personnel are prepared and in place for simulations
- Facilitates execution of simulations

2. Scenarios and Assessments

- Contributes to the design and execution of healthcare simulations, case scenario and assessment tool design
- Works closely with faculty to ensure case portrayal and learners' assessment aligns with simulation educational objectives and educational needs
- Plays an active role in the creation of SP training materials

3. Program Quality

- Works with the Medical Director and Asst Director of CSSC to develop assessment methods for Standardized Patient evaluation; collects and analyzes SP performance data; provides on-going feedback/remediation for Standardized Patients
- Supports faculty with data validation, reviewing student performance and identifying at risk learners and makes suggestions for their remediation
